



PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Brick Dragons South (herein named BDS) and other youth sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social and emotional development of children. It is therefore essential for parents, coaches and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self control.

I therefore pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
2. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
3. I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
4. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
5. I will not use drugs or alcohol while at any BDS event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
6. I will not permit my child, or encourage any other person, to use drugs or alcohol at any BDS event and will not permit my child, or encourage any other person, to attend, coach, officiate or participate in any BDS event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
7. I will not engage in the use of profanity.
8. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in the use of profanity.
9. I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
10. I will encourage my child to treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
11. I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
12. I will not encourage my child, or any person, to engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.



13. I will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
14. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee at any BDS event.
15. I will remain in the public domain at all times, unless special permits are/were issued to me by the Brick Dragons South. Failure to adhere to this may result in criminal trespassing charges.

I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, officiating or participating at any BDS event, I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by BDS and or New Jersey American Youth Football (NJAYF).
2. Written warning issued by BDS and or NJAYF.
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from the BDS sports event issued by BDS, or whomever is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection, namely NJAYF and or the Brick Township Police Department.
4. Suspension from multiple BDS and or NJAYF sports events issued by BDS, or whomever is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection, namely NJAYF and or the Brick Township Police Department.
5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by BDS, or whomever is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection, namely NJAYF and or the Brick Township Police Department.
6. Ejection by Brick Police Department, and or any/all criminal charges associated with your behavior here at BDS facilities.
